

UNUSUAL MOVEMENTS IN THE NEGOTIATION OF COX ENERGY AMÉRICA'S CAPITAL STOCK SECURITIES

Mexico City, May 12th, 2023 – COX ENERGY AMÉRICA, S.A.B. DE C.V. ("Cox Energy América" or "the Company") (BIVA/BMV: COXA*), the first photovoltaic solar energy company to be listed on a Latin American stock exchange, informs its shareholders and the general public that the unusual movements observed today in the trading of securities identified with the ticker symbol and series COXA* are market-driven conditions, and Cox Energy América is not aware of the causes that may have led to them.

Furthermore, the Company is not aware of any involvement by members of its board of directors or relevant executives in the movements observed. The Company does not have a repurchase fund in place.

This clarification is provided at the request of the Bolsa Institucional de Valores, based on the provisions set forth in Article 106 of the Securities Market Law and Article 50, penultimate paragraph, of the General Provisions applicable to securities issuers and other participants in the securities market.
